What is CELTA?

The Cambridge CELTA Certificate trains you in teaching English to speakers of other languages.

It is an initial teacher training qualification in what is commonly called TEFL (teaching English as a foreign language), TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) or ESL (English as a second language).

In the UK, CELTA is a Level 5 award on the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF).

Who is CELTA for?

CELTA is intended for:

- > Candidates with no previous teaching experience
- > Candidates with experience but no professional training
- > Expert speakers of English, native or non-native

You need to be 18 years old. You don't need to have a university degree but you need to have a standard of education acceptable for higher education in your country.



If you have learned English as a second language, you need demonstrate that you have a C1 or C2 level, although an official qualification is not obligatory.
